

One Health Master Training Program for 2024 has started



The “One Health Master Training Program,” which has been implemented by Fukuoka Prefecture since 2023, has commenced again this year as well.

The “One Health Master Training Program” consists of a total of nine sessions, which include classroom lectures (on zoonosis and the creation of a society in which humans and animals can coexist) and hands-on experience (forest walks, field trips, etc.).

Those who complete the program and are certified as masters will serve as lecturers at local study groups and engage in other activities to raise awareness of One Health.

〈What is One Health Master?〉

This person is able to teach the basics of One Health (philosophy, history, current status) to practical examples of One Health initiatives, and is actively involved in promoting awareness of One Health.



【Fukuoka One Health Master Referral Project】

Since March 1, 2024, Fukuoka Prefecture has been implementing a program to introduce One Health masters as lecturers for study groups in communities, workplaces, schools, and other venues.
