On December 12, 2024, FAVA One Health Fukuoka Office concluded an agreement with OISCA Nishi-Nippon Training Center regarding collaboration and cooperation in promoting One Health.

Additionally, vegetables grown at its training center have obtained One Health certification in Fukuoka Prefecture.
