Dr. Jacqueline W. Kitulu

(World Medical Association, President)

President of the World Medical Association (WMA), and a licensed Medical Doctor in private practice at the Karen Surgery, a multi-disciplinary practice, in Nairobi, Kenya. She previously served as the first female President of the Kenya Medical Association (KMA) and in many other positions. She has shaped the Kenyan health care system under Government appointments and nominations to key public service positions, and her catalytic interventions have earned her several awards presented by two Presidents of the Republic of Kenya. Dr. Kitulu has served as a Communication and Advocacy Panel Member at the World Medical Association (WMA), influencing digital health and advocating for medical ethics and the professional independence of physicians globally.

Keynote Speaker



1. Dr. William Sander

(Associate Professor of Preventive Medicine and Public Health, Department of Veterinary Clinical Medicine, Center for One Health Illinois, University of Illinois)

Dr. Sander is an Associate Professor for Preventive Medicine and Public Health and Director of the DVM/MPH Joint Degree program at University of Illinois – College of Veterinary Medicine. Part of his research and outreach is focused on improving interprofessional experiences centered on One Health including a currently required IPE for Carle Illinois College of Medicine, College of Veterinary Medicine, and College of Applied Health Sciences students. He teaches an elective Global One Health course, offered to medical and veterinary medical students. He serves on the board of directors for the Illinois State Veterinary Medical Association and the Veterinary Sustainability Alliance, and as the alternate Delegate for Illinois to the AVMA House of Delegates.



2. Dr. Avi Sarkar

(UN-Habitat Head of Office, Lao PDR)

Head of Office of UN-Habitat Lao PDR and Regional Advisor covering South-East Asia for urban basic services. With UN-Habitat, he has acted as project lead for regional initiatives such as Water for Asian Cities and Mekong Region Water and Sanitation Initiative (MEK-WATSAN). Currently, he is involved in leading several projects dealing with urban development, climate change, and other areas.



3. Dr. Shunsuke Managi

(Distinguished Professor, Kyushu University Director, Urban Institute, Kyushu University)

He is a professor at the Graduate School of Engineering, Kyushu University, a faculty fellow at the Research Institute of Economy, Trade and Industry, and a visiting researcher at the Policy Research Institute of the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries. He is the recipient of the 16th Japan Society for the Promotion of Science Prize, a council member of the 25th and 26th terms of the Science Council of Japan, and was selected in Clarivate World's Influential Researchers in Highly Cited Researchers. He has served as a director for the United Nations Inclusive Wealth Report, ISC working group member for UN The Global Sustainable Development Report 2023, member of UN Network of Economic Statisticians - Round Table on Measuring Capitals for Sustainability, an ad hoc member of the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry's Industrial Structure Council, an ad hoc member of the Ministry of the Environment's Central Environment Council, representative of the Science Council of Japan's "The Impact of Sustainable Investment on Industry," representative director of aiESG, Inc., and chairperson of the Natural Capital Credit Consortium.



4. Dr. Motoyuki Sugai

(Director, Antimicrobial Resistance Research Center, National Institute of Infectious Diseases, Japan Institute for Health Security)

He has served as a professor at the Hiroshima University Graduate School of Biomedical and Health Sciences, associate dean at the Hiroshima University Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences, and dean at the Hiroshima University School of Dentistry, before becoming director of the Antimicrobial Resistance Research Center at the National Institute of Infectious Diseases (NIID) in January 2018. He is active as an expert on antimicrobial resistance (AMR) in Japan, serving as a member of the Cabinet Office Food Safety Commission's Working Group on AMR and the Health and Science Council, as well as serving in international organizations, including as a member of the World Health Organization (WHO) Advisory Group (AG-CIA, AG-BPPL).
